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Who is this MBA for?

A flexible programme that allows you to study any time, any place; suitable for experienced managers unable to take significant time out of the workplace.

The Henley Flexible Learning MBA is a part-time programme that develops your international management competencies and connects your learning to current global and organisational issues.

The Flexible Learning MBA combines taught elements and intensive workshops to provide you with powerful tools and techniques to develop you for senior leadership positions and improve your effectiveness within your own organisation. The programme allows you to return to your organisation and immediately add value, by utilising the additional knowledge, skills and experience gained from all aspects of the curriculum.

Amongst the expected learning outcomes from the Henley Flexible Learning MBA you will be able to:

- develop a strategic, holistic and integrated perspective of business, organisations and management
- integrate theory and practice through an approach that combines academic rigour with practitioner relevance
- benefit from personal development opportunities to support your development of management capability and capacity to work in, and lead teams in, different situations.

Programme structure

The three stages of the MBA by Flexible Learning are delivered through a series of two or three-day face-to-face workshops across the three years of the programme. This structure is enhanced by group and individual study (an average of 12 to 15 hours per week over the three years) which supports your progression towards an MBA qualification.

The workshops comprise a variety of core subject modules. Stages one and two contain a further offering of elective pathways, providing the opportunity for you to develop other areas of interest and expertise.

The three stages of the Henley MBA by Flexible Learning are:

Stage 1 - Managing the organisation

Stage 2 - Making business choices

Stage 3 - Making a difference

Reviewing and strengthening personal development through self-awareness, career and competence building is a key focus across all 3 years of the programme. Your progression will be assessed throughout the programme using a range of methods including individual assignments, examinations and a final research report.
